Xtra Quarter Horses is home to NRHA Hall of Fame inductee Wimpys Little Step. In 2014, Wimpys Little Step achieved both NRHA Six and Seven Million Dollar Sire status and was named the Equistat No. 1 sire of reining horses for all ages and divisions for 2014. His offspring earnings have also made him NRHA's All Time Living Sire. His span of record-breaking achievements is so incredible that it continues to set new ground for other sires to follow.

The ranch is also home to Wimpyneed-sacoccktail, the NRBC Level (L) 4 Open Champion with Boechat in the saddle. The sire stands in the coveted position of Wimpys Little Step's Highest Money Earning Offspring (stallion) with over \$280,000 won in NRHA Lifetime Earnings (LTE). Shiners Voodoo Dr, the 2012 NRHA Derby reserve co-champion and one of Shining Spark's highest earning offspring, rounds up the trio with earnings of over \$85,000 earned in NRHA competition.

THE 2014 NRHA FUTURITY

The 2014 NRHA Futurity was an exciting event for Xtra Quarter Horses. The L4 Cinch NRHA Non Pro Futurity Champion, Blue Berry Jac (Wimpys Red Berry x Mainly Jac), was from the first foal crop bred, raised and sold by Xtra Quarter Horses. Wimpys Dolled Up (Wimpys Little Step x Dolled Up Gunner) was the L3 and L2 Non Pro Champion. Wimpy Chic, another horse sold by Xtra was the 2014 L3 and L2 NRHA Futurity Open Champion.

With these outstanding performances by Wimpys Little Step offspring, and the many others shown at the 2014 NRHA Futurity, Wimpys was able to hit the NRHA Seven Million Dollar Sire mark, making the show even more memorable. Xtra also raked in an impressive \$220,000 for the second highest seller at the NRHA/Markel Insurance Futurity Prospect Sale with the 2012 Bay Stallion, Xtra Voodoo Doc (Shiners Voodoo Dr x Call Me Miss Hickory x Docs Hickory).

This year's 2015 NRHA Futurity should be just as exciting, with the Xtra Breeders Futurity running alongside. It's the first incentive program of its kind, with an additional \$600,000 in prize money, solely funded by Xtra Quarter Horses. The payments are split across the board in both the Open and Non Pro Level 4 divisions. The

only requirement being that the entry must be sired by an Xtra Quarter Horses' stallion. There are no additional nomination or enrollment fees.

The ranch continues to grow as a busy, competitive, breeding and training operation. Putting the small town of Purcell on the map, it welcomes visitors from all over the world, many of them making the trip to see the reining phenomenon, Wimpys Little Step.
